

COVID-19: ARRIVAL FROM COUNTRIES AT RISK – DECLARATION ON HONOUR

Since July 6th, 2020, according to the *Epidemics Act* and the *COVID-19 Ordinance on International Passenger Transport Measures*,

Persons entering Switzerland from a country or area with an increased risk of infection (the list is on the Federal Office of Public Health website, on the link above, and is regularly updated) are required to **go into quarantine**, for 10 days. It is **compulsory**.

It implies that the concerned persons must report their arrival to the responsible cantonal authority within two days, and follow all the instructions of the FOPH and of the cantonal authorities.

The violation of these rules (including the obligation to report your arrival to authorities or to place yourself into quarantine) is punishable by law with a fine of up to CHF 10,000. Moreover, such a violation can be easily discovered as EHL is obliged to provide the list of students coming from countries or areas with an increased risk of infection to the cantonal health authorities.

The EHL Group attaches great importance to the health and safety of students, staff and entire EHL community. Therefore, it will not tolerate the violation of these rules by a member of the EHL community, as non-compliance with these rules expose persons present on campus or in EHL Group premises at high risk of infection.

Therefore, by signing this document, you acknowledge that you are aware of the obligations enacted by the competent authorities, that you must follow if you have entered Switzerland from a country or area with an increased risk of infection, and you certify on your honour that you have complied with the related legal requirements.

You also understand that any violation of these obligations happening at EHL, if discovered, will be reported to the competent authorities. In addition, it will be subject to disciplinary sanctions in accordance with the applicable regulations of the EHL Group.
